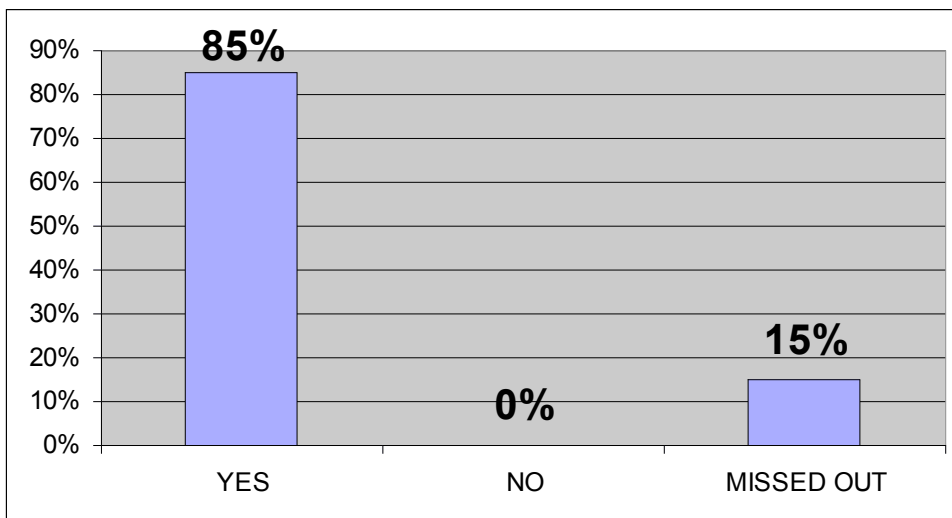

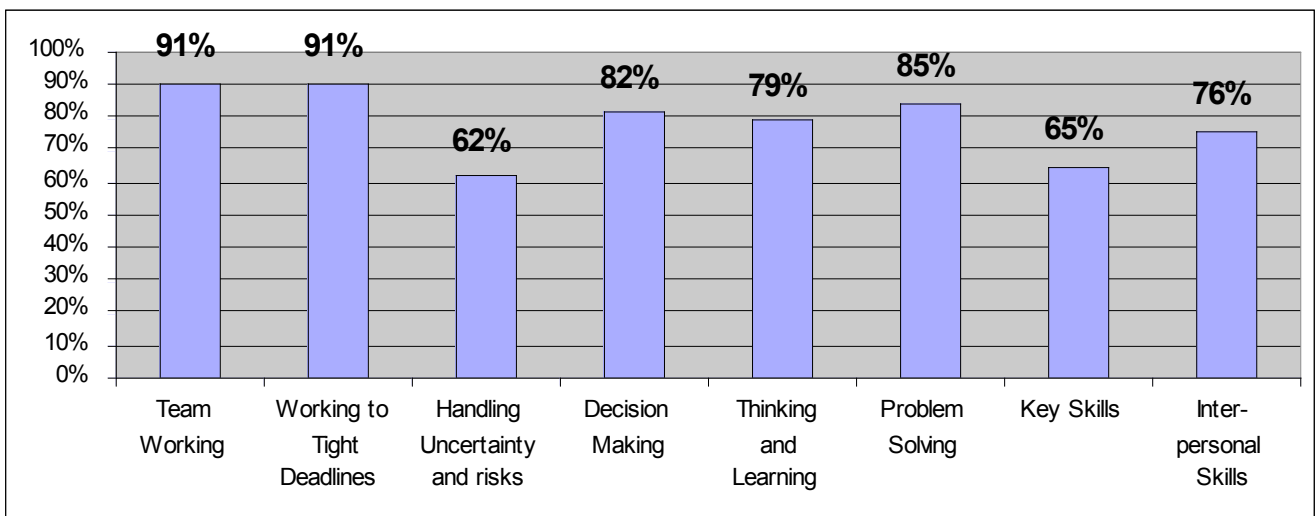

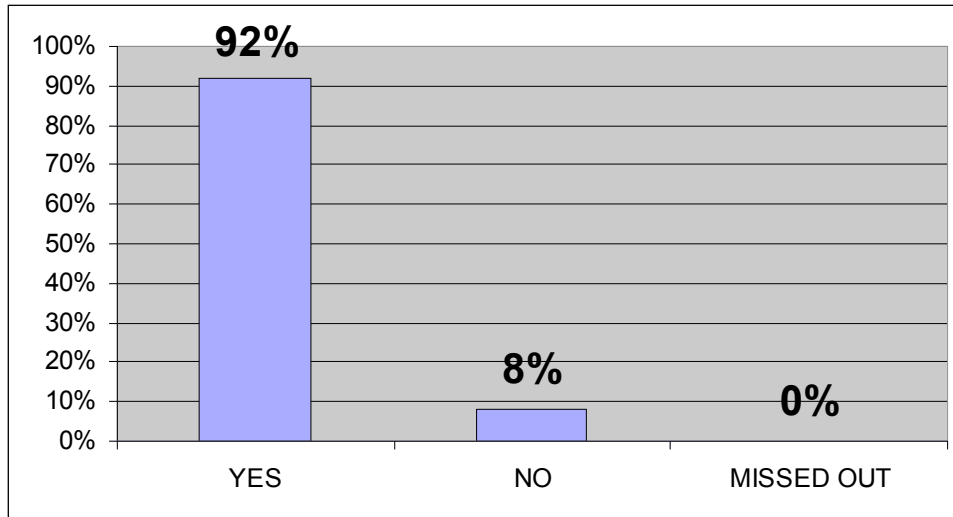

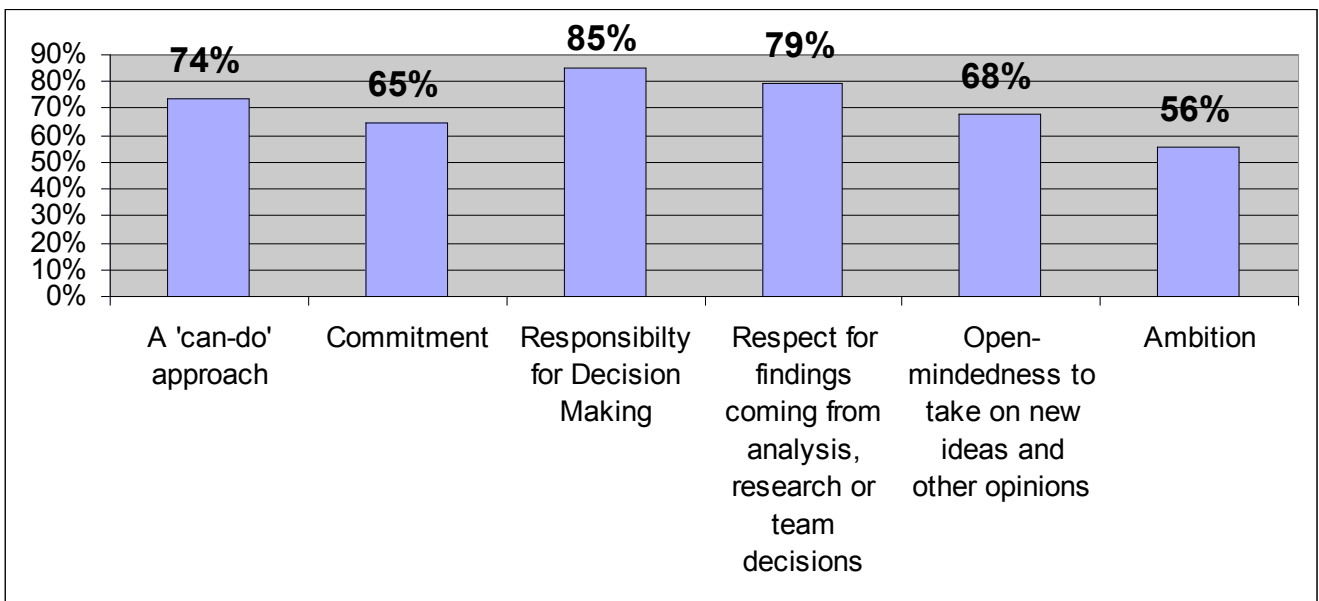

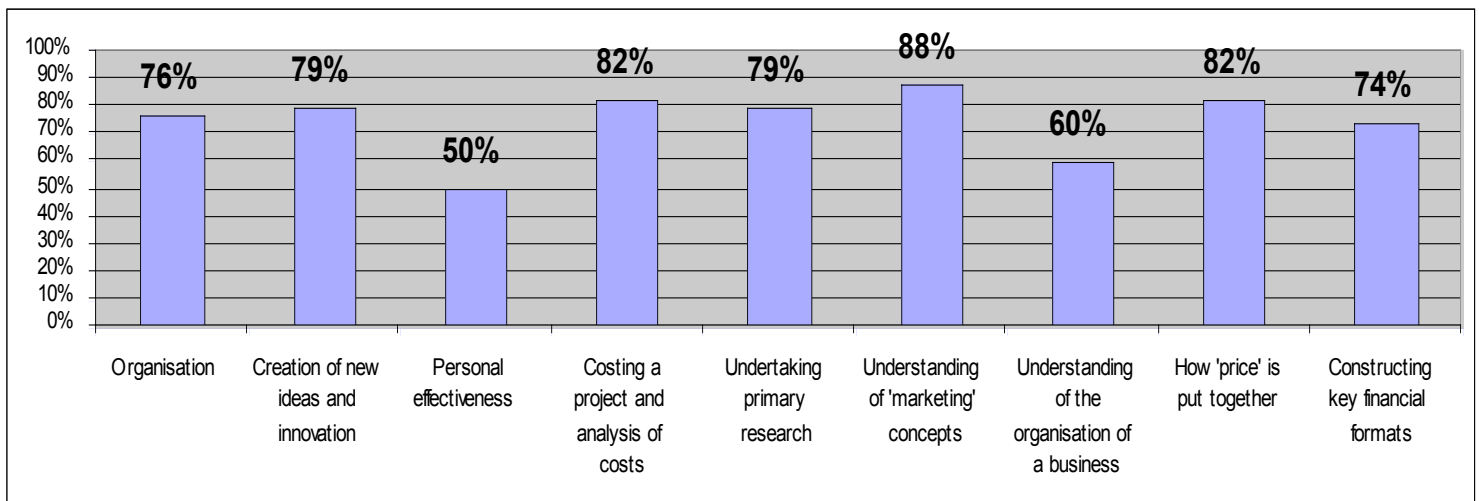

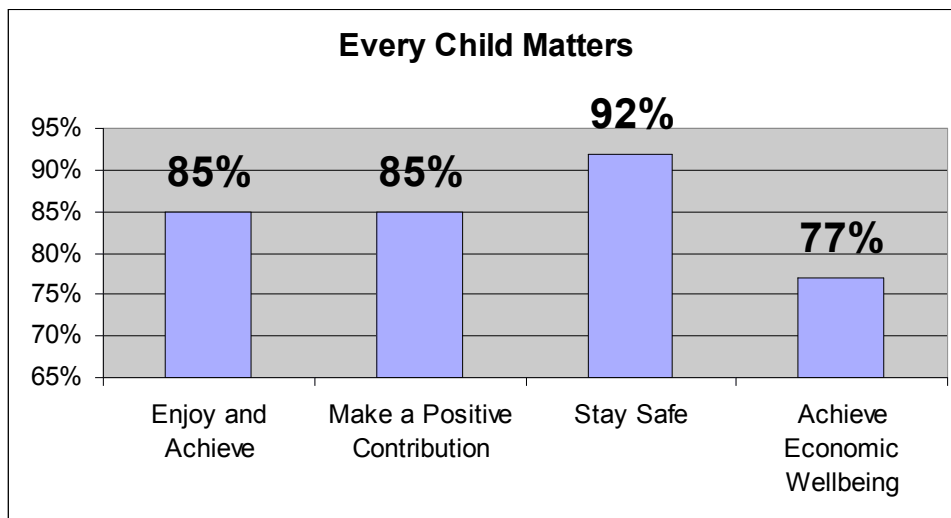

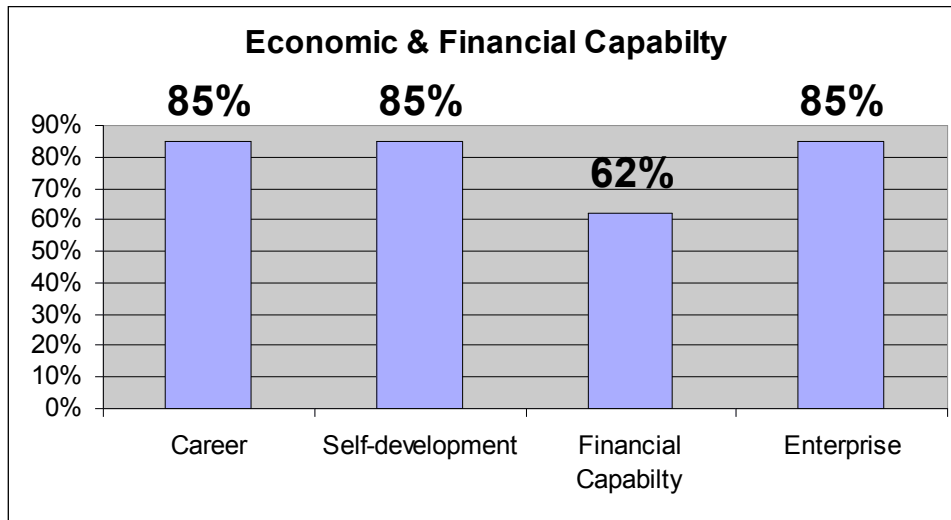

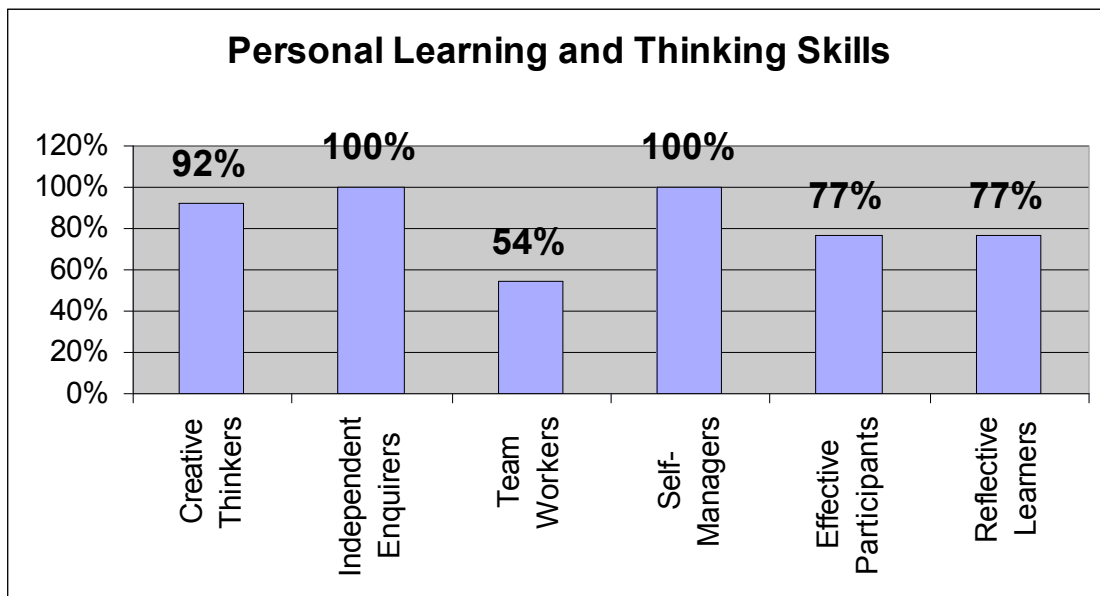
**(ii) ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL CAPABILITY**

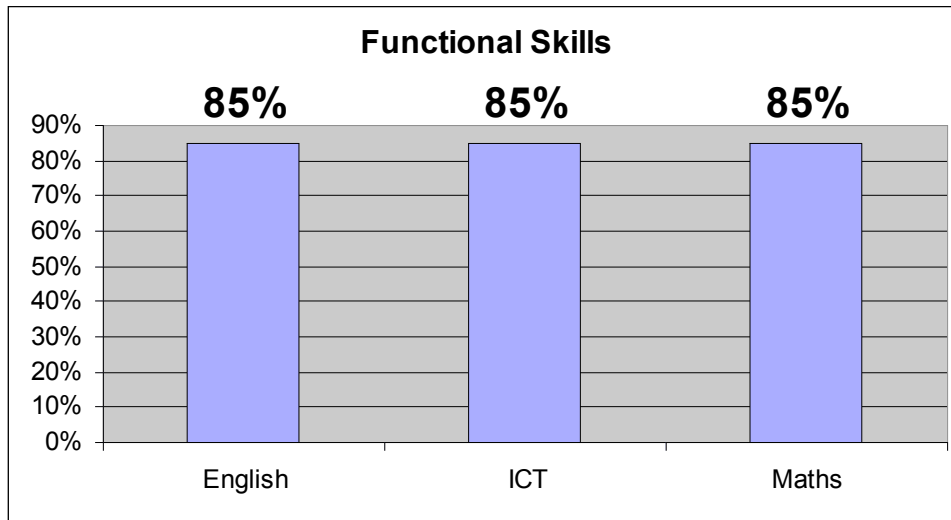
**(iii) PERSONAL LEARNING AND THINKING SKILLS (PLTs)**

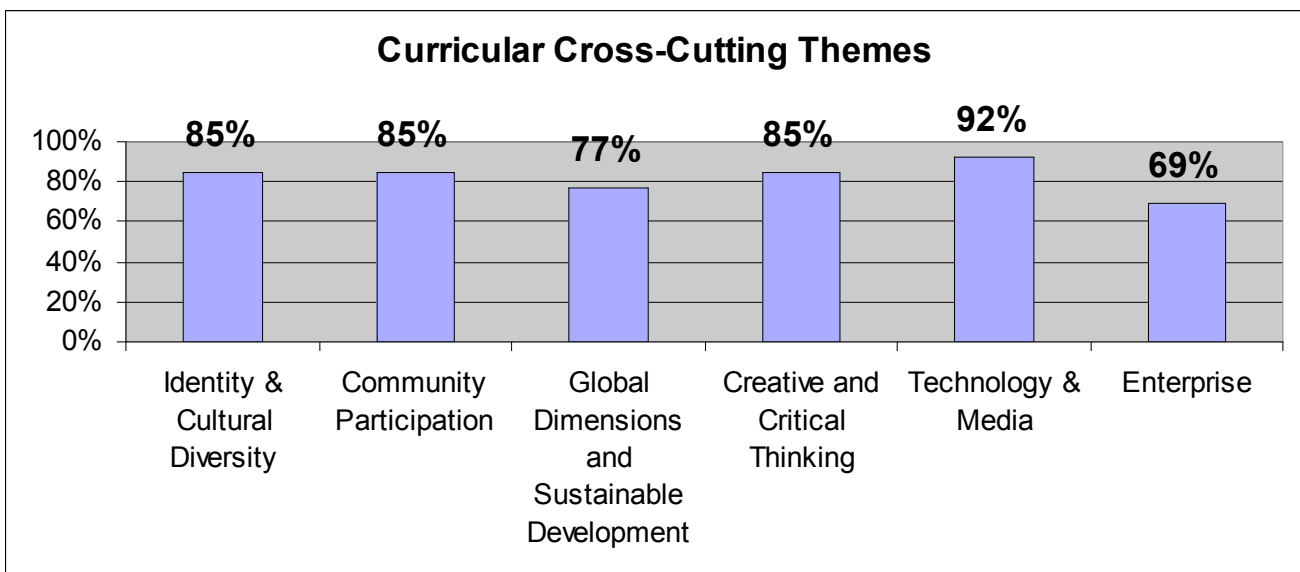
